



## Purpose of This Lesson:

This is the final lesson in the Prophecy Seminar. There are two basic things you want to accomplish through this lesson:

1. You wish to review everything you have studied in the Prophecy Seminar.
2. You wish to make a strong spiritual appeal to join the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

This lesson attempts to end the series on a very positive, upbeat note, dealing with the wonderful promises available to us on the new earth. It is very important that you take time at the beginning of this lesson to go through the review sheets.

Hopefully most of your students have already filled them out; however, the 35 questions will review every major point covered in the Prophecy Seminar. Therefore it is important that they have reviewed them at home and that you review them again to make sure their answers are correct.

Question 36 in the review section makes one final attempt to gain a commitment for membership in the Adventist Church. It says clearly that they understand the truth, accept the truth that they have learned, and that it is their desire to follow the truth and to be a part of the church fellowship.

When you review Question 36, encourage your students to sign the statement. You will not collect these sheets from them; however, one of the appeal questions in this lesson will ask if they have signed that statement. That's why it's important that you encourage them to place their names on it. Those who sign their names should be visited immediately and their decision sealed by setting a time for their baptism.

Have some follow-up activity scheduled, such as a Sabbath School class, a small group meeting, or a Wednesday night Bible study time. Please be certain to have something so that the seminar doesn't just die, leaving the people with nowhere to go when it is finished. Those who have completed the Prophecy Seminar need to know that there is a definite follow-up especially for them.

This review session will take nearly half of the time that you have allotted for this lesson. The rest of the lesson is fairly simple and you will be able to move through it very quickly.

The important thing to remember is to keep an upbeat note, especially on the latter part of the lesson as you deal with heaven. Talk of the glorious

place that God has prepared for His people and let them know how eager you are to be among those people who will be in the earth made new.

#### Question 2

Daniel was to receive his final inheritance at the time of the end. God's people in all ages will receive it then. Here is a strong text on the state of the dead. Everyone receives his inheritance at the same time: at the time of the end.

#### Question 3

The use of the term "kingdom" suggests reality, and not a figment of someone's imagination.

#### Questions 4 to 6

These questions elaborate the kingdom motif. Most people conceive of heaven as just a figment of the imagination, a fairy story. They have little conception of the reality of heaven. Therefore the bulk of this lesson tries to establish the fact that heaven is a very real place.

#### Question 9

Talk about the exciting thrill of traveling to that space city that God has prepared for those that love Him.

#### Questions 13 & 14

Many do not, believe that people will have real, physical bodies in heaven. To them, heaven is a spooky place where people have semi-material bodies. These two questions make it clear that people in heaven will have bodies exactly like Jesus' resurrected body. That body was not spirit, but flesh and bones. So will be the bodies of the saints in heaven.

The main difference between our bodies then and now is that they will no longer be subject to death, disease or sin. But they will be just as real as they are now.

## Question 15

While this text is not intended to give a detailed account of our activities in heaven, its basic message says that heaven is a place where people do real things. People are busy in heaven. It's not a place to sit around and twiddle our thumbs and do nothing.

## Questions 16-20

These questions talk about the beauty, glories and wonders of the place that God is preparing for His people. Let your excitement show as you go through this section. True, we can only faintly imagine what heaven is going to be like, but just talking about these things should fill us with joy and expectation. Heaven is a wonderful place!

## Questions 21 & 22

These two questions describe the holy city that God is preparing for His people. Don't get overly bogged down in details here. The main point to get across is the absolutely glorious place that God is preparing for His people, that it is far beyond human comprehension.

## Questions 23 & 24

Here is the real reason for going to heaven. We don't go because of the streets of gold or the gates of pearl; we want to go to heaven because that's where God is. Jesus is our best friend; we've grown to love Him. Therefore, we want to be where He is.

Give strong emphasis to these two questions, for this is the heart of the lesson.

## Question 25

Be sure to make this part of the lesson very Christ-centered. The only way we can go to heaven is through acceptance of Jesus Christ. Our right to heaven is not what we have done, but what He has done for us.

## Question 26

Be sure to give a very strong, spiritual appeal through these last two questions. You have done a lot of reviewing. At this point you are seeking to whet their appetite for the glorious land that God has prepared. You want to end your seminar on a very high spiritual note—the desire on the part of every person there to be in the earth made new.

## Response Questions:

1. If it is your desire to be in the new earth with Jesus, put a check in Box #1.
2. If you have placed your name on Question 36 of the review section, put a check in Box #2.
3. If you still feel that you need further time to study the various truths that you have learned in the Prophecy Seminar and you would like me to pray that God will help you to make your decision to follow these truths very soon, put a check in Box #3.

In closing, be sure to have a strong appeal prayer in which you pray for the people who have learned these great truths in the Prophecy Seminar. Let them know that they will still be in your prayers.

Remind them of the follow-up meetings, and then be sure to visit, visit, visit.

The end of the seminar does not mean you drop the people.

Continue to visit, continue to follow up, and God will give you many of these precious souls for His kingdom.
