Everlasting Gospel Bible Studies Lesson 6 NEW BIRTH AND CONVERSION

God has provided salvation for all who believe in, and accept, Christ's sacrifice and ministry on their behalf. Although many people know that Christ died for their sins, not all understand how to receive the free gift of salvation, or what it entails.

A question echoes repeatedly through the corridors of time, from the lips of kings, rulers, and common people alike. We all have had occasion to reiterate this pointed, essential, yet basic question, What must I do to be saved?

In today's study we will discover God's plan for our salvation and how we may experience the new birth. The Bible says, "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." John 3:3

A. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF OUR GUILT

What must we first acknowledge if we are to be saved?

Jeremiah 3:13

B. REPENTANCE FOR SINS

NOTE: True repentance always brings about a genuine sorrow for our sins and turning away from them. As we behold Jesus hanging upon the cross we are brought to realize what our sins have done to Him: they have broken His heart.

NOTE: Self-generated repentance does not enable us to turn away from sin. God supplies as a gift the deep repentance required for salvation.
