The first three chapters of the Bible (Genesis 1, 2 and 3).tell how sin entered this world; and the last three chapters of the Bible (Revelation 20, 21, 22) tell how sin will be eradicated from the earth. The chapters between tell how God related to this awful tragedy.

The punishment for sin is death. Romans 6:23. The ugly malignancy of sin could not be tolerated ,else, it could endanger the universe. The super-tragedy of sin is, that when Adam and Eve disobeyed, sin passed to all mankind, and thus all people, from that time to the present, face the death penalty.
