REVELATION'S LAKE OF FIRE

Revelation, in most graphic language, repeatedly refers to the lake of fire, hell and the punishment of the unsaved. Fifteen times Jesus pointedly mentions the lake of fire so John will know that the fire is not a fable but rather a very necessary part of God's plan to abolish sin and make the righteous safe for eternity.

However, grave problems confront many when they study the subject of hell in Revelation. Thinking people have been shocked to read that the unsaved will be "tormented day and night forever and ever" — Revelation 20:10 (1823), because such words fill the mind with serious questions about God's mercy and justice.

Are all the wicked punished forever regardless of the degree and number of their sins? Does a sinner who died three thousand years ago receive three thousand years more punishment than one who dies today and is lost for the same sin? How can God get rid of sin if sinners are kept alive forever in a fire? In light of these questions, this subject becomes one of exceeding great importance.

Millions have turned their back on Jesus because of such teachings and others have said, "If God is like that, I hate Him!" At stake here is the character and reputation of the great God of heaven. Let us examine carefully the Bible evidence.

GOD'S FINAL JUDGMENT

1. When will the wicked be punished in the fire? II Peter 2:9 (1787)

Ans: "The Lord knoweth how to . . . RESERVE the UNJUST unto the DAY of JUDGMENT to be PUNISHED".

- Judgment of the last days is no judgment at all – if punishment already meted out.
- 3. Souls do die (Ezekiel 18:4,20, see question #7).

 All wicked dead

 are in graves now,

 awaiting the resurrection

 of damnation.(John 5:28,29)
- 4. Whether you are wicked or righteous when you're dead, you are really dead until in God's power you are resurrected!
- 5. The reward of the wicked is not eternal torment but eternal death!
 The "wages of sin" is not eternal torment according to God's Word.
- 6. The "second death" is final,
 notice from where the fire comes
 to devour the wicked. (Revelation 20:9)
 From heaven (not somewhere in the earth).
- 7. We don't "have a soul";
 we are "souls"!
 and we are subject to death!

24. Will sin ever rise up again after it is destroyed in hell fire? Nahum 1:9 (1361)

Ans: "Affliction shall not rise up again the SECOND time".

NOTE: Praise God! Never again will sin rear its ugly head.

25. What will God do after sin and sinners are destroyed? Isaiah 65:17 (1102); Il Peter 3:13 (1789); Revelation 21:3 (1823)

Ans: a. Isaiah 65:17 (1102); II Peter 3:13 (1789) - "Be-

hold I create new HEAVENS and a new EARTH

... wherein dwelleth righteousness. b. Revelation 21:3

(1823) — "God . . .will DWELL with THEM

NOTE: Utterly fantastic! God moves in with His people on the new earth to be their loving Father and neighbor. Everything that Adam and Eve lost will be restored, Acts 3:19-21 (1595). God's people will, at long last, have found joy unspeakable without end.

GOD IS NOT UNMERCIFULLY PUNISHING WICKED PEOPLE IN THE FIRE RIGHT NOW! ABSOLUTELY - NO WAY!

NOTE: ALL former things are passed away. No exception is made to keep hell burning somewhere in God's universe. God's plan is to completely rid the universe of evil. An eternal hell would perpetuate sin and evil and make it impossible to ever forget it.

Ans: LOVE

NOTE: No one will be in heaven because they were afraid of hell. People will be in heaven because they loved Jesus first, last and always. And those who love Jesus will have no need to fear hell, I John 4:18 (1794).

23. Earthly governments cannot remain stable without the meting out of justice. But some say God is too loving to ever punish or destroy the wicked. What does the Bible say? Exodus 34:6,7 (145)

Ans: "The Lord. . .will by NO means CLEAR the GUILTY ".

NOTE: It is because God IS loving that justice is a must. God's justice is based upon the choices people make after being fully informed. It would be unfair to impose a life-style upon a person contrary to the one he has chosen. Divine justice is just as essential as divine love. In fact, divine justice IS divine love. God loves us enough to permit us freedom to choose the life-style we prefer. God's justice simply insists that we receive what we have chosen with all of its consequences. Those who choose sin choose death, Romans 6:23 (1655); Proverbs 8:36 (976).

SOME WONDER about Bible passages which speak of being tormented FOREVER and EVER; ETERNAL fire, EVERLASTING punishment, UNQUENCHABLE fire, and THE RICH MAN AND LAZARUS. For a discussion of these points see EXHIBITS # 1 and # 2.



GOD'S FIRE DESTROYS

At the end of the 1000 years (Rev. 20), the Holy City with all the saints comes down from heaven, and settles on the Mount of Olives. The wicked of all ages are resurrected and Satan leads them in a dramatic attempt to capture the City. At this time fire comes down from God out of heaven. This is the "hell fire" spoken of in the Bible.

NOTE: The fire will be the exact size of the earth because it will be the earth on fire. The elements and the earth will melt from the heat and everything on the face of the earth will be burned up.

- 10. All of these thoughts concerning the final judgment and execution of punishment on the wicked show completion. The fire from God does its work, destroys the wicked, and they are no more.
- 11. Nobody can escape God's fire. Even Satan can't put it out. After it does its work of destroying the wicked it burns out. It has accomplished its purpose.
- 12. A few ashes, and a wisp of smoke – it's all over!
- **13.** Psalm 37:10 wicked gone 37:11 meek inherit the earth
- 14. I can visualize Satan as the last to be destroyed because of His former great strength and his hatred of God he just won't give in until the very last! He sinned more and suffers longer.

NOTE: It is slander on the holy name of God to accuse Him of far crueler and more heartless treatment of people than has occurred in the very worst of war atrocities. Eternal torment is not a part of God's great plan. Such a teaching has made Godhaters and infidels of many people through the centuries. An eternal hell of torment would be hell for God who loves even His worst enemies with a love that is indescribably deep and heartfelt.

19. For whom did God plan the fires of hell? Matthew 25:41 (1443)

Ans: "Prepared for the **DEUIL** and his **ANGELS** ".

NOTE: God prepared hell to destroy sin, the devil and his angels. His plan is to isolate sin and then eradicate it from the universe with fire. Like a cancer, sin would jeopardize the universe unless eradicated. The ugly cancer of sin must be destroyed in the fire. If I hang on to sin I will have to be destroyed with it. God cannot permit that ugly thing which deals such misery and woe and which killed His Son to enter His new kingdom. He pleads with me daily to let Him remove sin from my life and bury it under the sea, but He will not force it. The choice is mine. If I choose to go my own way here I would do the same in heaven. Besides, those who refuse to follow Jesus here would be in abject misery in a place where only holiness exists. It would be cruel to force them to live under such conditions.

GOD'S LOVE VINDICATED

20. What is God's act of destroying people in the fire called? Isaiah 28:21 (1055)

Ans: "His strange WORK ... His STRANGE act".

NOTE: Jesus came to save people. Destroying even those who hate Him is so contrary to His nature that it is called His strange act. God's great heart will be torn asunder when He is forced to destroy those whom He dearly loves, Ezekiel 33:11 (1263). He is not willing that any should perish, II Peter 3:9 (1789). He will cry out as He did with Ephraim, "How can I give you up?" Hosea 11:8 [Phillips Translation (1330)]. And He will with anguish ask, "What more could I have done than I did do to save them?" Isaiah 5:4 (1029). It will be the most horrible moment heaven has ever spent when God's disobedient children must be destroyed because they refused His love.

- **15.** Even Satan will finally die. Yes, the wages of sin is DEATH (not eternal torment as Satan would have us to believe). He wants to discredit the character of God and cause us to be afraid of Him.
- **16.** The lost are "souls" they don't "have souls". They are real human beings ("souls") burning bodily in real fire from heaven.
- **17.** The Bible says that Satan will be responsible for many people losing their lives (souls). If lost, God will destroy you not just a part of you. Remember, only God hath immortality! (I Tim. 6:16) There is no such thing as an Immortal Human "Soul" separated from the body.

NOTE: The scripture makes it easy to understand. Both soul and body are destroyed in hell. Everything that comprises a person: his intelligence, personality, life and all else that makes him an individual will be destroyed in the fire.
